Currently, she is a scientific senior researcher at the Institute of Romanian Philology "A. Philippide", from Romanian Academy, Iaşi Branch, as editor of the Thesaurus Dictionary of the Romanian Language. She is interested in words, their history, their circulation, how communication between people who speak the same language or different languages influences the evolution of words / languages.

Among her research interests are: lexicography, lexicology, romanian philology and computational linguistics.

She is involved in various national (CLRE. Corpus lexicografic românesc esențial. 100 de dicționare din Bibliografia DLR aliniate la nivel de intrare / Essential Romanian Lexicographic Corpus. 100 dictionaries from DLR Bibliography aligned by entries; Dicționarul tezaur al limbii române / Thesaurus Dictionary of the Romanian Language – national project of the Romanian Academy, etc.) and international projects (DÉRom (Dictionnaire Étymologique Roman) (Première phase: le noyau panroman); ENel: European Network of e-Lexicography, COST Action IS 1305, etc.), which has allowed her to communicate with very different people, coming from different cultures.

She is also passionate about the evolution of Romanian research, digitalization and the integration of research directions in Romania into what is happening internationally.
